The PICCA Education & Training Program serves to provide employment and training services to income eligible individuals who are disengaged or dislocated from school and work. Through partnerships with area employers the program provides innovative training tracks in Residential and Commercial Construction, Clerical/ Reception, Maintenance, Vehicle Preventative Maintenance and Detailing, and Automotive Technology.

HOW IT WORKS

The program provides:

- Education and job skill opportunities to income eligible individuals
- Students participate in 24 hours of education and job-skills training
- \$216 stipend each week.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE

Men and women who are committed to a drug-free lifestyle, are of age 18 and older, and meet income guidelines.

OUR EXPECTATIONS

Participants must show up, be on time, remain committed to all aspects of the program, and be willing to believe in their ability to succeed and overcome the challenges in their life.
